## The Chronoscope

The Chronoscope, designed by Local Projects for the Times Square centennial celebration, is an interactive kiosk that permits time travel via a map of the bustling New York neighborhood overlaid with dates. When a date is selected, a historical photograph of the location appears juxtaposed against a present-day image. The visitor navigates the sophisticated 3-D map by moving from photo to photo, skipping back and forth in time. "It's a great example of collaboration between architecture and design," Sayegh said. "Not only do the photographs bring the architecture to life, they allow one to see how the area has developed."
